### AGM Format Change:


The AGM notice was sent by email recently and there is a change to the nomination and voting method as per the special meeting held late last year. Should you not have received notification of the AGM notice and are a current member please contact the Secretary urgently to have a copy sent to you as there is a time limit to get your nomination/s in.

#### **To summarise how voting will work:**

- 1/ Anybody wishing to be considered for a position must be nominated and seconded using the form recently sent out. Let us know if you need a copy. This applies to the existing committee as well.
- 2/ You can nominate yourself but need a seconder.
- 3/ Should only one person be nominated & seconded for a position then they will automatically hold that position and this will be ratified at the AGM.
- 4/ **Nominations are to be made to the Secretary by 22 April 2018.**
- 5/ Should no nominations for a position be received by 22 April then it will be elected from the floor at the AGM.
- 6/ Should any position/s have multiple nominations then a vote will be carried out at the AGM. If you are not able to attend the AGM, voting papers are available from the Secretary. And can be E-mailed or Posted to the Secretary to arrive no later than 48 hours prior to the AGM. Proxy votes at AGM still apply but there is a maximum of 2 per person.

So it is important if you are considering going on committee to get your nomination in. You may not have a chance at the AGM if there is only one nominee they will be confirmed in the position at AGM.

Please ask the committee should you need more clarification.
