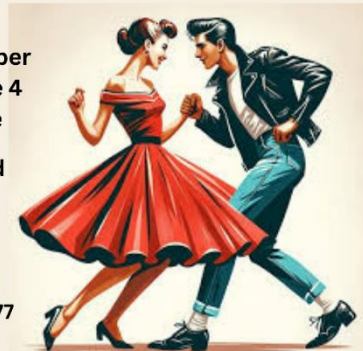

Access is from Queens Drive. Inside we will have tables and chairs set up on the floor and there is additional terraced seating around the hall that will be available.

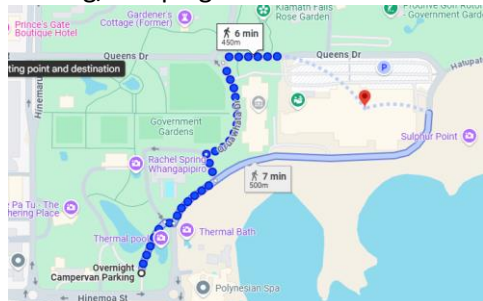
